The Reality

- 54% of children in the Brazos Valley are eligible for the Free and Reduced lunch program. This is 3 times the national average.
- 24% of children in the Brazos Valley are living at or below the national poverty level
- Texas has the highest rate of uninsured individuals (28% of general population), and the Brazos Valley is slightly higher (29% of general population)
- There are 585 IDENTIFIED homeless children identified by CSISD and BISD
